Normally this is a good sign, but not this month because \$450 came from the sale of a radio and \$500 came as a donation from Sempra Energy. Without these extra one time amounts, we would have been in the hole. That is because we missed payments from two tenants who are normally on time. Counting what they owe this month, our accounts receivable total \$7,242. Membership renewals for 2014 as of today total 7, and brunch reservations total 18 (not counting mine). 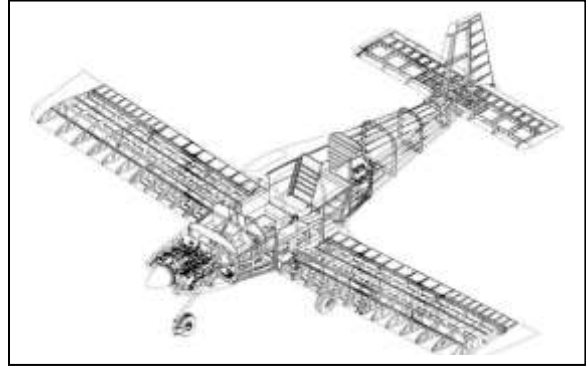
