There is much going on in our Chapter these days. Let me give you a taste. Elections, managerial changes, policy decisions, holiday planning, membership renewals, let alone routine operations.

Three Directors are up for re-election at this month's Members meeting. Since there are no contested seats, it is pro forma and I don't anticipate widespread protests on this one! We truly appreciate Dave Bristol, Rhon Williams, and Rich Gieser returning to the Board for another two-year term.

The annual Holiday Brunch, a Chapter favorite, is schedule for December 4 at 11:00 a.m. We are returning to Marie Callender's in Torrance. This event nearly sells out so get your reservations in now! A highlight is the annual auction that raises funds for an aviation camper. We voted this past week to reserve a spot in the Senior Camp at Oshkosh. So, come for some fun and fundraising! Auction items are needed and can be anything you wish. \$35/pp, same as last year, pay online or submit a check.

We are losing people in three key positions. Our Hangar Manager, Young Eagles Coordinator, and our Treasurer are all stepping down. The Executive Board met to find a solution to the Hangar Manager role and the end result was to split the duties into three categories; hangar management, facilities management, and supply management. In these positions will be Gus Gustavson, Richard Gieser, and Jim Lobue, respectively. With the change in Young Eagles coordinator, two new members have accepted the challenge and take a dual approach to this. Dustin Wallace and Christopher Lord will be making a presentation on their plans at our January Board meeting.

Also at the Board meeting, we opted to have our bookkeeping done outside as we have not found someone internally with Quickbooks and accounting experience who is willing to handle the position. We are hopeful this will be a three month trial and have limited the budget to a palatable level. Should anyone know of the right person who can assist us, we're all ears.

We are renewing our commitment to a clean environment around the hangar and will require all users to maintain the areas they use. Besides tenant spaces, if you use the restrooms, the kitchen, or the Board Room, please tidy it up upon leaving. It only takes a minute. In 2017 we will schedule bi-monthly cleanings. Tenants will be asked to participate so we know what belongs to whom. In addition, the Chapter owns a wide variety of equipment. This equipment is available to members as a member benefit. A checkout/check-in system will be used for tracking.

Our membership drive and renewals are in progress. Paying dues now will take this off your plate for the next year. Please remember, you **MUST** be a current member of the National EAA organization to join a Chapter. This is for insurance reasons and **YOUR** protection. We are moving closer to being able to check this regularly.

Lastly, another initiative that we have fallen away from is the wearing of name badges at meetings and Chapter functions. Expect this to be strongly encouraged in 2017. It promotes networking and finds resources for getting things done. Stay tuned for a Chapter announcement on how to acquire a badge if you don't have one.

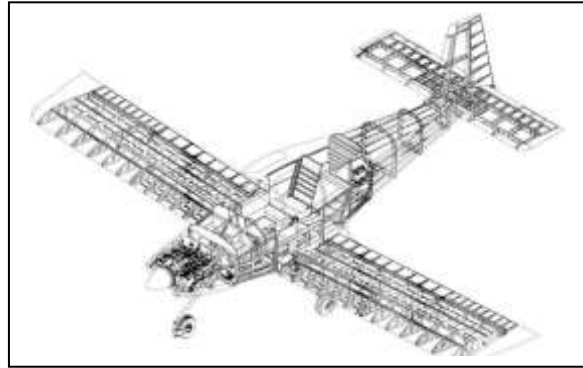
